

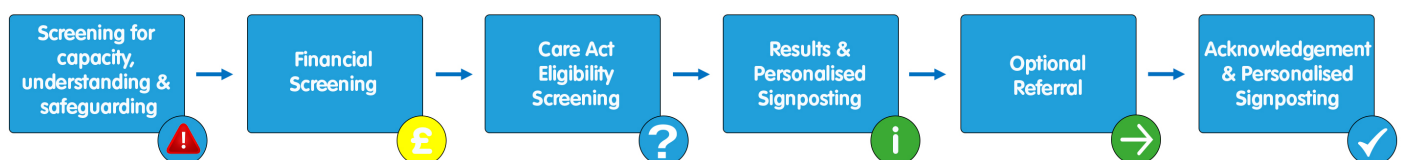


# Adult Screening and Information Tool

## Empowering Citizens and Achieving Channel Shift

Open Objects' Adult Screening and Information Tool quickly and anonymously signposts citizens to personalised information, advice and services based on their needs and can provide the likelihood of their eligibility for care and support.

Our tool sits at the heart of adult social care digital transformation and supports the Care Act's preventative agenda, covering its ten eligibility domains. Supporting councils by empowering citizens to self-serve, the tool helps to reduce the number of unnecessary referrals into social care.

## Benefits:

- » No barriers to information – the first part is completed anonymously
- » Screens for capacity, communication difficulties and safeguarding
- » Assesses the user's financial situation and offers indication of potential contributions
- » Captures independence and likelihood of eligibility across the Care Act domains
- » Dynamically offers personalised links to information, advice and services based on the user's need
- » Information and services can be curated by the local authority, offering the opportunity for more targeted and effective results over general directory searches
- » Provides an optional direct electronic referral for further discussion or assessment

## Proven, robust, effective

The Adult Screening and Information Tool has been developed in two distinct halves.

**Part one** offers a set of questions about the individual's needs and financial situation without them having to share their personal information.

Results are presented showing:

- If someone may benefit from further assessment of their social care needs
- The likely financial contribution towards any eligible support provided
- Signposts towards tailored information, advice and services, based on their needs.

**Part two** offers the option to make an electronic referral into adult social care where the person is asked for further details about their needs and their personal details.

Used by a number of our customers across England, the tool is an engaging addition to our community Information, Advice and Guidance (IAG) Hubs and is supporting individuals to take control and manage their personal health and wellbeing.
